What stands out to you?

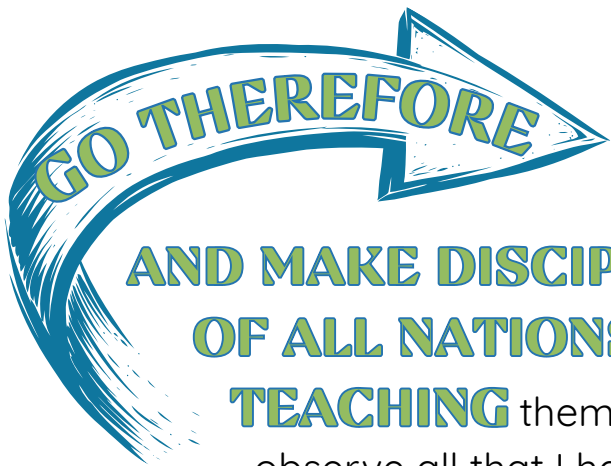
DRAW
