El Kanna (Jealous) [EL kan-NAH]

When we hear the word jealous it often carries a negative connotation; a trait we do not want to have.

But God is called El Kanna, which means jealous.

One definition of jealous is: "demanding faithfulness and exclusive worship" (Oxford Languages).

As our Elohim (Creator), God **rightfully** demands both our exclusive faithfulness and worship.

It is this righteous jealousy that El Kanna embodies!

READ

Read and discuss:
Exodus 34:13-14
1 Samuel 5:1-5
Acts 17:22-29

PONDER

What things can become idols for your family (anything elevated above God)?

OBSERVE

God wants us to look for Him (Acts 17:27). Start a family list of God Sightings! Where do you see God (in nature, in situations, etc)?

PRAISE

Praise God through prayer and song for who He is! You can even have a dance party of praise!
