The stories of Simeon and Anna are short...but powerful! God spoke to them and allowed them to meet Jesus as a baby—God let them see firsthand that He kept His promise to send a Savior—to each of them & the world!

What is something you have seen God do in your life that caused you to marvel? Praise God for that!


### PRAISE
