Just like we put our shoes on to get ready to leave the house, God wants us to always be ready to share the truth of Jesus with those around us!

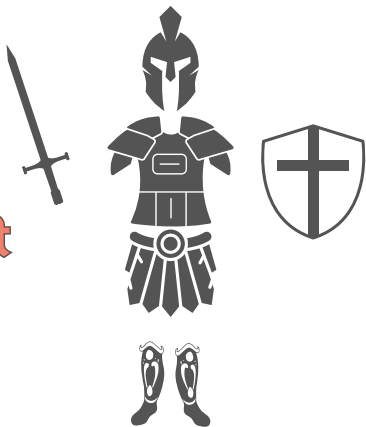
Acts 8:26-40 gives an account of Philip sharing the truth of Jesus with a stranger.
