Pray for God to give your family wisdom and help keep everyone focused on God!

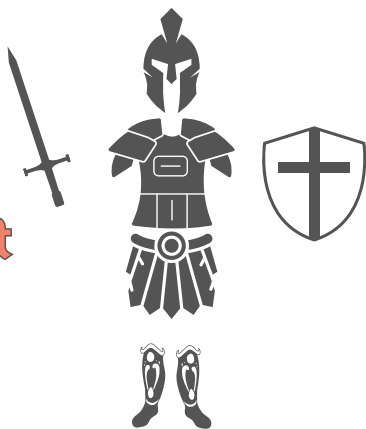
